- In the first section we present the main results of the activities of a research project financed by the University of Pisa (PRA 2016) and coordinated by Giulia Romano.
- The research project addressed some relevant and current issues about the **management** of water utilities and the sustainable water use.
- Cutting edge tools have been used to investigate these issues in order to cover the existing gaps in the literature.
